On Thursday, September 25, 2014, the North Andover High School Environmental Club assisted the Conservation Department with a stormwater education program to mark storm drains on the North Andover High School Campus. The markers are meant to educate students, teachers and visitors to the school that stormwater on site drains to the wetlands and streams nearby including Cochichewick Brook. Items

that flow or are deposited into the catch basins eventually make their way to these waterways influencing the quality of the environment and the water downstream. Stormwater pollutants include oil, pathogens, heavy metals, fertilizer, salts, and common litter.

Charles Anderson, Environmental Club Advisor, offered the club's services late last year to help the town meet federal requirements to provide educational outreach about stormwater to the community. The Environmental

Club was organized approximately 5 years ago by students who wanted to discuss and get more involved in environmental issues. The group is responsible for starting the school wide recycling program which has been expanded to the Cafeteria. The Club has also done campus cleanups, trail maintenance in Harold Parker State Forest and at Weir Hill, organized and planted a community garden (with help from the tech classes). Their work extends beyond North Andover including a raffle to raise money for the Cheetah Conservation Fund in Namibia, hosting a program about the Student Conservation Association to promote student community service (3 NAHS members were accepted and spent 3 weeks building trails in New Jersey last summer), as well as a photo shoot for 350.org. The Conservation Department looks forward to working with the Club on this new environmental project.

NEWS FROM THE TOWN CLERK'S OFFICE



The Town Clerk's office is extremely busy after the September Primary Election on September 9, 2014. We are preparing for the November 4, 2014 State Election. We have the following reminders;

The last day to register to vote for this election is Wednesday October 15, 2014. The Town Clerk's Office will be open until 8:00PM on that date.

If you need an absentee ballot forms are available on our web site www.townofnorthandover.com. You can also call our office at (978)688-9501 and we can assist you. Once ballots are received (usually mid-October) you may vote in Town Hall in person. You may also request a ballot be mailed to you. The ballot can be delivered to Town Hall or mailed back.

We encourage you to request an absentee ballot if you are unable to get to the polls, travel and may be out of town, or are a student away and school. A family mem-

ber can request the ballot. A drop box is available in front of Town Hall and is checked daily.

The High School is closed on Election Day. Polls will be open from 6:00AM until 8 PM. Police are available outside the Fieldhouse voting door if you need assistance. If you are not certain if or where you are registered to vote visit www.sec.state.ma.us to check voting status and have information regarding ballot questions and candidate information.
